Short Report on Training Programme

The training programme started at 9.00 A.M. on 25.12.2014. First of all, the participants registered their names. Then pre-test (Written Evaluation Test Part-I) was done. Following this, performance evaluation pre-test was conducted. After this, a short inaugural function was organised in which, Dr. Ashok Kumar Behera, Superintendent of M.K.C.G. Medical College Hospital, Berhampur, was the Chief Guest and Dr. S.K. Agrawalla was the Guest of Honour. Mrs. Mamata Acharya, Principal (I/C), College of Nursing coordinated the programme. After welcome address by Dr. Bijaya Kumar Panigrahy (Course Coordinator), the training programme was inaugurated by lighting the lamp before lord Ganesh by Chief Guest and others. The instructors briefly narrated the aims and objectives of this training. By 10.30 A.M. the training programme started. First of all, the participants are grouped into 5 groups like Group-1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 consisting of 9 trainees each. Five workstations were arranged and one instructor remained In-Charge of one workstation (Workstation-1 : Dr. Budhia Majhi, Workstation-2 : Dr. U. Sridhar Murty, Workstation-3 : Dr. Bijaya Kumar

Panigrahy, Workstation-4 : Dr. Aditya Kumar Mohapatra, Workstation-5 : Dr. Bipin Chandra Padhi). Instructors remained fixed in their respective workstation, but participants rotated clockwise after each skill, so that all participants are exposed to all the instructors. From 10.30 - 01.00 P.M. Video projection was done on (1) Preparation for Birth, (2) Routine Care, (3) Initial steps. After projection of each skill, the instructors demonstrated the skills practically to the participants at respective workstations. Following which each and every participant practised the same skills. There was lunch break from 1.00 PM. - 2.00 P.M.

In the post-lunch session, video projection was done on (1) Brief ventilation, (2) Prolonged ventilation with normal heart rate and (3) Prolonged ventilation with slow heart rate.

After projection of each skill, again all the instructors moved to their respective work stations and demonstrated the skills practically. Following this, the participants practised the skills. Since this is the most important skill in BNCRP, all the instructors took maximum interest and care in teaching this skill to the participants. At last the basic mega code was projected. Following this performance evaluation post-test as per the exercise check-list was conducted. At last post-test (written evaluation test Part-I) was done. Participants are requested to handover their feedback sheet. Later on valedictory function as arranged. Certificates were distributed to the Trainees by the Instructors. At last Principal of Nursing College gave vote of thanks. Persons from electronic media attended this programme and gave good media coverage in newspaper and local TV channels.
